

### WORLD TV AWARDS 2013 CATEGORY HUMANITY The Best TV Documentary Dealing with Natural Disaster

## **CRITERIA AND REGULATION**

# *Genre:* Documentary

#### Length: A maximum of 60 minutes

All the entries will be judged according to the following criteria:

- 1. The programme must effectively cover natural disasters and focus on the efforts to manage with its consequences.
- 2. The programme must represent an outstanding example of a programme that deals with aspects of natural disasters in a positive manner. The programme must be able to capture the outcomes of the natural disaster, as well as the responses, either by the public, media, government or international organisations.
- 3. The programme could either focus on a local, regional or on global point of view.
- 4. The programme should be creative and innovative with the ability to capture audience attention, and offer excellent production values.
- 5. The programme must have been aired or must be scheduled for broadcasting in its originating country on national and/or any private TV network (broadcasting sheet to be provided).
- 6. The programme must have been produced in the last 24 months before submission.
- 7. The programme must be either in English or in any other language with English subtitles. It can also be without words.
- 8. The programme must be the original work of the entrants. Entrants must be able to demonstrate that they have full copyright clearance on all music, image, artwork and other audio-visual elements used in the programme.

Who can submit an entry?

⇒ Television producers from public service broadcasting organisations, private networks, freelancers etc. are invited to participate in this competition.

How many entries can be submitted? ⇒ Each producer/organisation can submit up to 2 entries.

Format requested:

⇒ Programmes must be submitted in **DVD format.** 

⇒ **3 DVDs** are requested for <u>each</u> programme submitted.

#### **Deadline:**

The entry forms and the DVDs should reach AIBD <u>no later than</u> Monday 15 April 2013.

#### Jury:

Jury members are senior media managers from various countries and regions.

#### Prize:

⇒ **US\$5,000.00 cash** in favor of the producer and/or broadcasting organisation

⇒ **A trophy and a certificate** presented by the Asia-Pacific Institute for Broadcasting Development (AIBD)

⇒ **A trip to Manado, Indonesia** to receive the trophy and the certificate at the Asia Media Summit (AMS) on 29 May 2013, a global gathering of broadcasters.

#### Note:

 $\Rightarrow$  The announcement of the winner will be posted on the AIBD website from Monday 6 May 2013.

 $\Rightarrow$  The winner will be invited to attend the Asia Media Summit 2013 in Manado, Indonesia, a global gathering of broadcasters.

 $\Rightarrow$  The AIBD Director and representatives of the sponsors will hand over the prize to the winner during the AMS.

 $\Rightarrow$  A video clip of the winner's programme will be screened during the AMS as well as during the AIBD General Conference organized in Yangon, Myanmar from 12 to 15 August 2013.
